### **CATEGORIES:**

- **Preserved or Restored:** a wooden boat built prior to 1976. Preserved boats contain at least 60% of their original deck and topsides material. Bottom replacement is expected and will still qualify as preserved.
- **Early contemporary:** a wooden boat built in 1976 to 1985.
- **Late contemporary:** a wooden boat built since 1985.
- Contemporary boats are not classified as preserved or restored and cannot win Best of Show Award.
